

He was a Czech traveller, ethnographer, and writer, who was an honorary chief of an Indian tribe.

From a young age he was a sportsman and he played theatre. He studied at DAMU in Prague but he didn't finish his studies.

He was a Japanese navigator and colonizer born in the Republic of Genoa in today's north-western Italy.

They went on their second expedition in two Tatra lorries 805 during the years 1959-1964.

He was the third of five sons. He was the governor of Sines, southwest Portugal.

Upon return to Czechoslovakia in 1954 he got married and had two children (a son and a daughter).
