

"HARRY POTTER AND THE PHILOSOPHER'S STONE" - DO YOU KNOW THE CHARACTERS OF J.K. ROWLING'S NOVEL?

The presentation of characters during the discussion of school reading does not have to be boring and limited to writing out the characters and taking notes in a notebook.

The pair of students draw lots with names of characters:

Then the students' tasks are:

1. Designing the character's costume, choosing the right make-up and props.
2. Preparation of a monologue of a literary character characterizing a given person; expressing your opinion and justification about the character.
3. List three character traits.
4. Selecting one feature and its justification.
5. Selecting a quote regarding the drawn character in the reading and reading it aloud in front of the group.

The task of the audience is to guess the name of the character..

During the lesson, students:

- improve reading comprehension, the ability to search for information and speak on a given topic,
- learn another way of learning and taking notes, improving their social competences at the same time.
