


Madonna S.S. Del Lume

The Bourbons built a rustic church dedicated to the Madonna del Lume, protector of Porticello. The venerated painting of the Madonna del Lume painted, according to tradition, by the priest Jan Antonio Genovese is still preserved in the church. During his wanderings he arrived in Porticello where he found so much authenticity of faith and wanted to leave them a slate painting of the Madonna del Lume.

In fact, it is said that the picture was painted by the Jesuit under the guidance of the Madonna herself who blessed it. Popular tradition provides us with a second version linked to the sea, according to which the picture would have been carried by the waves of the sea, by divine will, to the pier of San Nicolicchio.



The Porticello festival, in honor of the Madonna Del Lume, begins nine days before the first Sunday in October, but the real celebration is on the first Sunday in October and on Mondays. The festival is celebrated in Piano Stenditore (the largest square in Porticello) which in this period is filled with stalls where everything is sold.

In the same evening a singer of national importance performs, and finally a fireworks display is staged.
